# "In One Place"

Psalm 8, Matthew 28:16-20

The gospel of Matthew does not offer as many details as to what happened after the resurrection of Christ as do the other gospels. Matthew says that Jesus rose from the dead and then met the disciples in Galilee. We will read the story of this meeting on Sunday and see that some of the disciples worshiped and others doubted. Does it come as a surprise that some of the disciples doubted? They were Jesus' closest followers. If they doubted, how would they be able to witness? Doubts are vital to faith, but we cannot let skepticism paralyze our obedience. We must be *In One Place* (not two), the place of complete devotion to our resurrected Lord.

I was recently asked "when I say *I'm In* at First Baptist, what am I saying I'm in to?" This is an excellent question. My first answer is that saying *I'm In* is a commitment to Jesus Christ. It is putting our most valued resources (time, ability, and money) into God's hands in the faith that God will use them to deepen our church's life in Christ and empower us to impact our community with God's love. When you say *I'm In* with your prayers, service, and finances, you are saying that you believe in a God who is working through churches like ours to make the world a better place. There's more to my answer to this question, and I look forward to sharing it with you on Sunday.


