
New Job Descriptions & Titles for Ministerial Staff

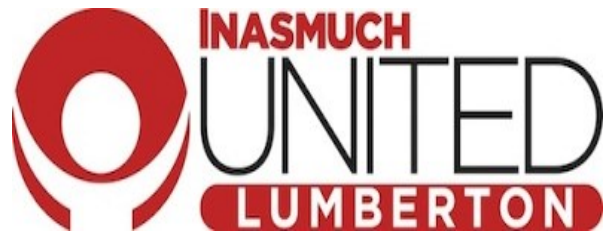
