
We are excited to host the All County Chorus as they prepare and present their concert this Friday. The concert is free and open to the public.



# CHILDREN'S CORNER

In a little over two weeks, we will have our first "5<sup>th</sup> Sunday Fellowship" on March 31. To encourage community, fellowship, and worship, we will have a church-wide breakfast in the fellowship hall starting at 8:45 am, followed by a combined service in the sanctuary at 10:00 am. In preparation for this day, the senior adult committee has been busy planning breakfast, and our sanctuary choir has been faithfully rehearsing their cantata. Here's what you can expect to experience:

Breakfast – While the official start time is 8:45 am, it's okay if you arrive later than that! The full breakfast time is 8:45-9:45. There will be no separate nursery or children's activities; this is an opportunity for all ages to fellowship together.



Worship – At 10:00 am, the Sanctuary Choir will present the cantata *The Body of Christ* by Pepper Choplin. Through music, they will tell the story of Jesus through the perspective of his body – the physical body of Christ that lived among us and was sacrificed for us, the symbolic body of Christ that we eat and drink in communion, and the body of Christ that we are, today. The music beautifully expresses themes of gratitude, sorrow, and hope through the retelling of Christ's life, crucifixion, and burial.

Our prayer is that this time of worship will be a meaningful opportunity for reflection and remembrance at the midpoint of our Lenten journey together. The service will include communion, as well as the traditional "presentation of the church key" to the class of 2019 to kick off Youth Week. Regular nursery care will be provided during this service.

In the spirit of flexibility and community, we are asking everyone to be present on this day. The schedule is intentionally different from our normal Sunday morning, which may push us all a little out of our comfort zones! Still, we hope you will choose to come that morning to experience this time of worship and fellowship together with our full family of faith.




