◆ Breakfast – While the official start time is 8:45 am, it’s okay if you arrive later than that! The full breakfast time is 8:45-9:45. There will be no separate nursery or children’s activities; this is an opportunity for all ages to fellowship together.

◆ Worship – At 10:00 am, the Sanctuary Choir will present the cantata *The Body of Christ* by Pepper Choplin. Through music, they will tell the story of Jesus through the perspective of his body – the physical body of Christ that lived among us and was sacrificed for us, the symbolic body of Christ that we eat and drink in communion, and the body of Christ that we are, today. The music beautifully expresses themes of gratitude, sorrow, and hope through the retelling of Christ’s life, crucifixion, and burial. The service will include communion, and regular nursery care will be provided during this service.

Noon Services will be hosted by churches in our community Wednesdays during the Lenten Season. A light lunch will be served following each service.

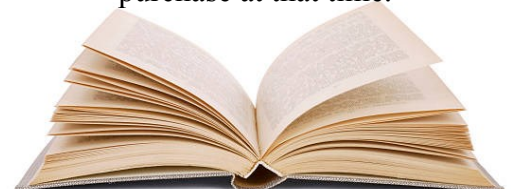

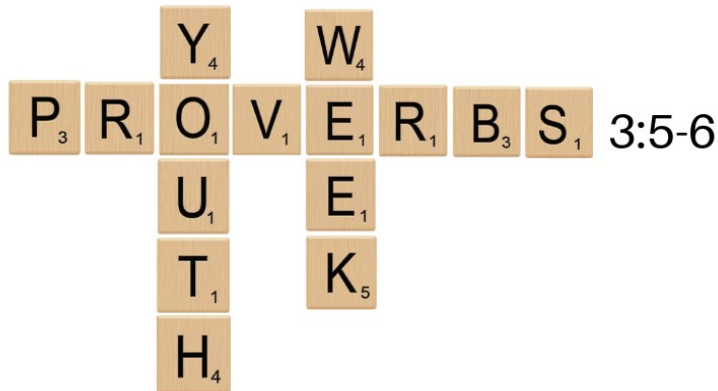

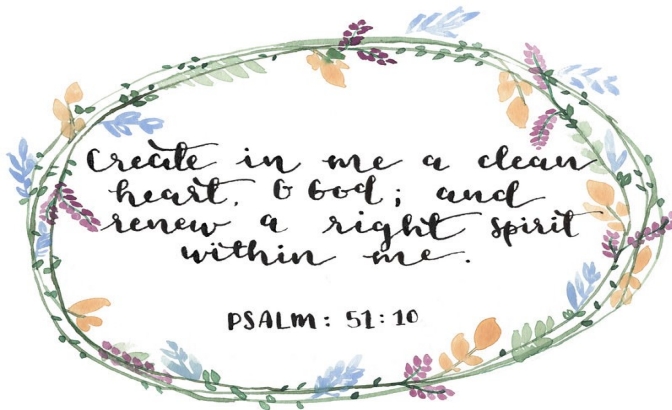
