Deacon Election



Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the membership is encouraged to vote for deacons by absentee ballot the week prior to October 4.

To Vote for Deacons:

- Call the church office to make arrangements to come to the 6th Street entrance between 9 a. m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday, September 28 through Friday, October 2, to receive and submit absentee ballots.
- At a called church conference to be held on Sunday, October 4, 2020, at 12 noon at the 6th Street entrance to the church (weather permitting), otherwise under the breezeway behind the Margie Cockrell Children’s Building. Masks will be required and social distancing will be practiced.

The ballots submitted throughout the week and at the called church conference will be counted by the Deacon Election Committee. The results of the election will be reported first to the nominees and then will be posted online.
