


During the Sunday School hour December 11th, bring your favorite Christmas treat to share as we listen to the Friends of Jesus Class sing!

I would like to take a moment to let you know where the money goes that you so freely give. Each student is given a list to fill out so that Santa will know exactly what to buy. The list has spaces for sizes of clothing and other necessities. You see, our students depend on our help to provide basic items like dresses for the ladies to wear to church and shirts and pants for the men.
