



Lumberton Christian Care is one of our most important local charities. Since the onset of COVID, LCC has been fighting hunger and homelessness locally with one hand behind their back. The rooms that provide temporary shelter have been operating at single occupancy, while the lunchroom has provided to go plates only.

Finally, they have received the good news that they can consider fully open the dining room and house more guests. Yet, they are limited by the same practical concern that limits what we are able to do as a church...lack of volunteers. Once they have enough people willing to help serve lunch (from 10:00-11:30 AM weekdays), they will reopen the building. Per Barbara Andrews, FBC member and LCC Board Member, the greatest need for help is on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday.

This is a wonderful opportunity to fulfill the expectations Jesus set for us in Matthew 25. Another way to be a sheep is volunteering to help with our Friends of Jesus class. Our Friends of Jesus are a wonderful ministry that we can do extremely well (if we have the workers we need).

Please pray about where God would have you be salt and light. The Nominating Committee may be in touch soon. We have openings for folks to help leading worship this summer. Great things are happening for God's kingdom through First Baptist. It is much more fun to be an active participant than a spectator. Let us know if you are ready to join in.
