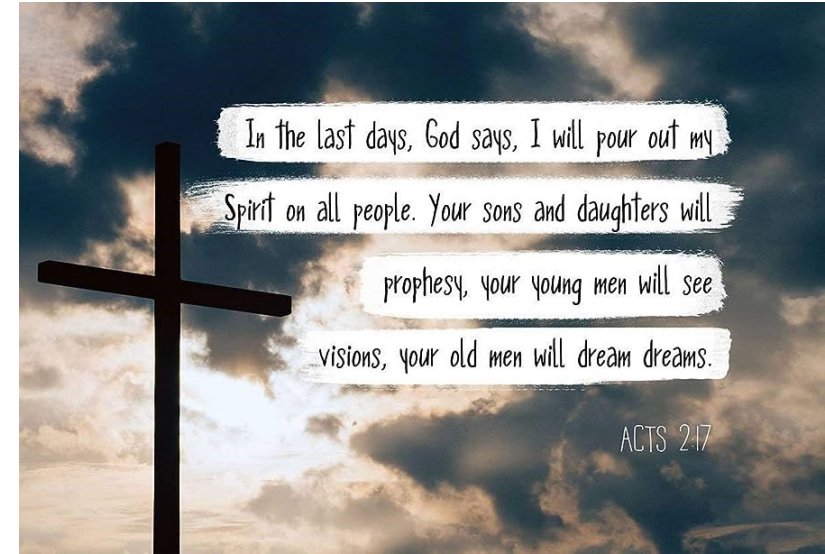

Their deepest and most unimaginable pain has brought even greater purpose to their lives and to their ministry. They believe, now more than ever, that the local church is the hope of the world and a hospital for broken and hurting people to find our way back to God. Their passion is to equip the church to care and to respond to the ever-increasing number of individuals and their families who are struggling with some aspect of their mental health.
