What does the color of the cloth on the cross mean?

One of the many visuals we use during Lent and Easter is draping the cross with a colored cloth. The cloth is not just decoration, but the three colors used during Lent and Easter are used to represent the life, death, and resurrection of Christ.



Purple: The symbolic color of royalty. The purple cloth represents Christ as King, reminding us that Christ is our Savior and King, and we are saved only by his grace and mercy. The purple cloth remains on the cross during Lent (from Ash Wednesday to Maundy Thursday).



Black: The symbolic color of darkness and mourning. The black cloth represents the suffering and crucifixion of Christ. The black cloth remains on the cross from Good Friday to Saturday, the day Jesus was in the tomb.



White: The symbolic color of burial cloth. The white cloth represents the resurrection of Christ. The white cloth remains on the cross from Easter Sunday through Ascension Day. This year, the white cloth will be on the cross March 31—May 9.



On Palm Sunday, March 24, 2024, FBC Lumberton will be having a Palm/Passion Sunday service at 10:30 am in the Sanctuary. During this service, children will be invited to wave palms. If your child would like to participate in this or any other element of worship, please contact Rev. Josh Owens or Rev. Doug Reedy. Children's Sunday School classes should plan to meet in the Sanctuary for rehearsal during the Sunday School hour.

A church-wide Fellowship meal will follow Worship. This will include an egg hunt! Please RSVP for the meal and egg hunt online through ACS Realm or at the bulletin board by March 15th.

We need donations of pre-filled eggs and individually wrapped candy for the egg hunt. Eggs can be purchased filled, or you can fill them yourself with candy or non-candy treats. We have



gotten mostly pre-filled eggs containing jelly beans so far, so other types of treats are requested. Candies donated should be individually wrapped and in their original packaging. Drop off your donations to the church office.

On Easter Sunday, we invite you to bring flowers to place on the cross outside of the Sanctuary. You can bring handpicked or purchased flowers.


No Wednesday services, Youth Doing Missions, or children's activities will be held March 27 and April 3.
