While FBC has been using a version of ACS software for church management for quite some time, we upgraded a few years ago to a more user-friendly version that can also be accessed by members. ACS is a relatively local company based in Florence, SC. The newer version of ACS is called Realm and is a web-based program. With Realm, staff are able to maintain an online church directory, post contributions, track registrations for trips and activities, and a variety of other administrative tasks.

Realm even allows for online giving and text (mobile) giving! Contributors are able to set up onetime or recurring gifts. While this is similar to our bank draft program, it allows you to have more control of your giving. Bank drafts are automatically deducted from your checking account on the 5th and/or 20th of each month for a set amount and are posted to the general budget, but with Realm you have the option to choose your own recurring gift dates, amounts, and contribution fund. You will be able to choose to make contributions to a variety of programs and missions supported by the church. The QR code included in the "Give to First Baptist Church" published in the newsletter and Order of Worship will direct you to Realm Giving options when you scan it with your cell phone's camera. Realm's online giving portal may also be accessed by visiting https://onrealm.org/ FirstBaptistChu67135/give/now.





In addition to giving options, Realm allows you to register for upcoming events through the Connect feature. If a trip or activity has a cost, you may pay for it online using your debit or credit card upon signing up. If you just sign up and still wish to pay with cash or check, or want to call and pay over the phone, that is all fine as well.

We are using an invitation only model for Realm, which offers more security since administration has to review and approve each join request. If you wish to be sent an invite to join, please contact Kandace at 910-739-4336 or kandaceramsey@fbclumbertonnc.org and provide her with your name and email address.
