


You may have noticed that we have featured a different non-budgeted line item each of the past few months such as security and Community Café. One of the things many people may not be aware of is the number of calls and doorbell rings we receive nearly daily from folks in need. Sometimes, we can place them in contact with a local agency depending on their need (food, shelter, etc.). Occasionally, after a long conversation, we discover the need is legitimate, urgent, and no one else can help. That's when our designated monies for community assistance are put to work to provide a night's stay at a motel when the weather is bad and the shelter is full, some food items for a single mother to last until pay day, or a bus ticket to a city with opportunities that don't exist here.

Helping in this way requires to use a great deal of discernment. We are conservative with the use of these funds, but even then they can become depleted. As always, your primary giving should go toward the general fund, but if you are looking to go above and beyond, giving money designated to community assistance is Matthew 25 in action.




Hosts for Community Café


