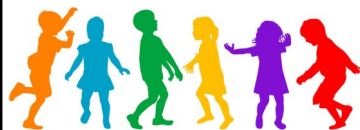

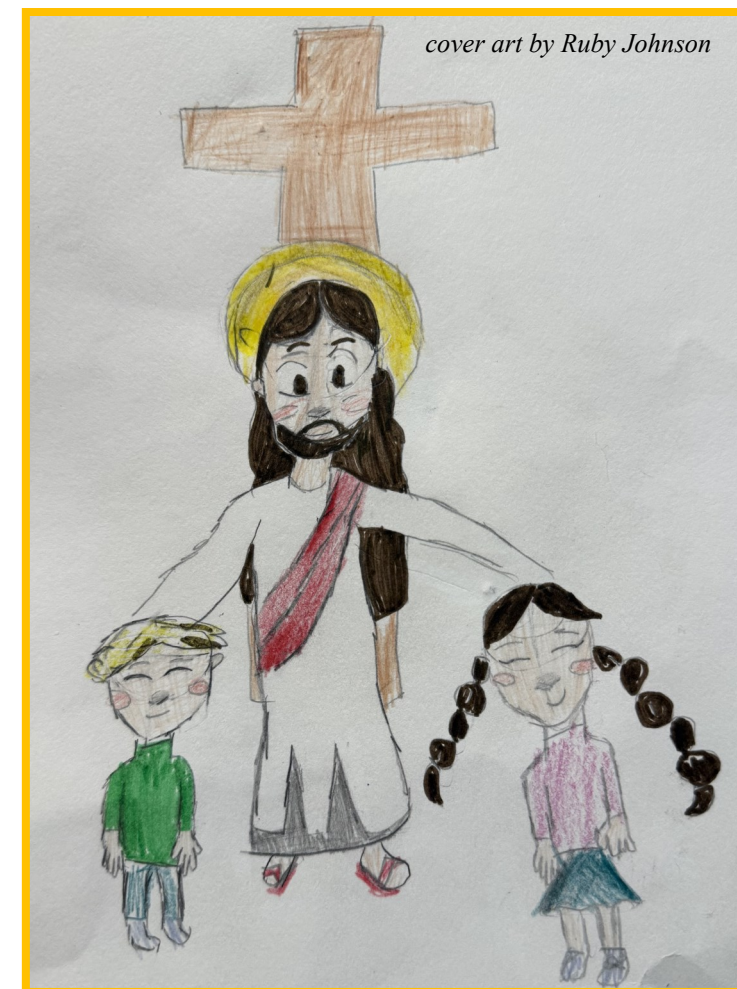
**May 26 is Memorial Day. The offices and Early Childhood Ministry will be closed.**

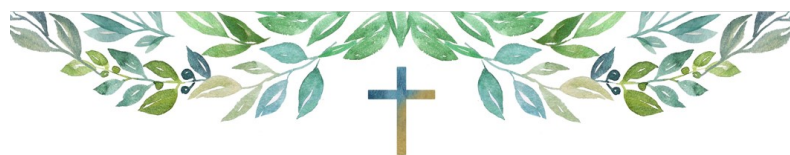
