The Longest Night: An Advent Memorial Service Sunday, December 21 at 5:00 p.m. in the Chapel

The Longest Night Memorial Service will take place Sunday, December 21st at 5:00 pm in the Chapel. This date coincides with the onset of Winter, a time characterized by the longest period of darkness in a day. The event is intended for individuals experiencing grief due to recent bereavement or any loss, regardless of the duration since the event. Candles symbolizing hope will be lighted during the service, and a crocheted snowflake ornament will be provided to those who have lost a loved one within the preceding year. This keepsake serves as a token of God's comforting presence and tranquility.
